
#### **Natural Resources**

#### **US** Imperialism

Imperialism- The system, policies, and/or practices of one nation to establish economic and political hegemony over other countries. Imperialism is the highest stage of capitalism. (Lenin 1916)

### 1947- Military Bases Agreement

- Granting the United States a 99year lease
- 20 bases or military reservations in the Philippines
  - -Clark Air Force Base
  - -Subic Naval Base
  - -Largest US bases outside of the United States

- Amerasian or mestizo babies left without fathers








#### Filipinos Protest US Bases

- 1992-Bases close under Aquino government
- Victory for Philippine Sovereignty

### The Visiting Forces Agreement

- □ 1999-RP-US Visiting Forces Agreement (VFA)
- Legal framework to permit the stationing of US soldiers in the Philippines

#### VFA: Nature, Scope, Problems

Unlike the bases treaty, the VFA has no duration. For all intents and purposes, it is in effect...FOREVER.



#### VFA: Nature, Scope, Problems

The VFA does not specify or limit the:

Number of troops

Areas in the Philippines that the "visiting" troops can access

Activities of the "visiting" troops

#### VFA: Nature, Scope, Problems

 The US forces can deploy or station an unlimited number of troops anywhere in the Philippines for whatever unspecified activity.

## What are the effects on the Filipino people?

■ Trampling of Philippine national sovereignty

■ Abuse of Filipina Women

Human rights violations (abductions, extrajudicial killings, etc.)

#### Trampling on Philippine National Sovereignty

 Philippine foreign policy shows full puppetry and dependence on US

 The Philippine and US governments have sought to take away the gains achieved in the struggle to remove US military bases in the Philippines

#### Accidental Killings

- Balikatan ("shoulder to shoulder") exercises.
  - US forces conduct military "exercises" on the southern island of Mindanao, in areas such as Zamboanga, Sulu and Basilan, areas that are considered at the center of armed conflict.

- Massacre in Hacinda Luisita in Tarlac
  - Rebelyn Pitao
    - Teacher in Davao City
    - Father suspected of having links to the NPA (New People's Army)
    - Abducted, tortured and killed by elements of the AFP
- Chris Hugo
  - Member of League of Filipino Students (LFS)
  - Addressed various issues of the education system, such tuition fees
- Diosdado "ka Fort" Fortuna
  - Leader of the Nestle workers' union
  - Chairperson of the KMU regional chapter of Solidarity of Workers in Southern Tagalog
  - On strike since 2002

#### Abductions and Disappearances

- 2006- Cadapan and Karen Empeño
  - Two student activists who were abducted
  - Reported to have been tortured and raped elements of AFP in Military camps
- 2007 Jonas Burgos
  - Activist and son of the late renowned progressive journalist Jose Burgos
  - Abducted in broad daylight in a crowded mall in Quezon City by elements of the Philippine Military
- 2009- Melissa Roxas
  - Filipina American activist
  - In Philippines volunteering as a health worker in Tarlac
  - Abducted and tortured by elements of the Philippine Military
  - Resurfaced



#### How are we connected to the VFA?

- US taxpayers
  - Unnecessary economic burden
- US military aid to the Philippines:
- □ 2006 = \$ 30 million
  - □ 2007 = \$30 million
  - □ 2008 = \$30 million
  - 2009 = US is projected to give another \$30 million
- Obama's and GMA have already pledged their commitment to a "long standing alliance," particularly the Visiting Forces Agreement (VFA).
- Filipinos (Filipino diaspora)
  - Continued emigration of Filipinos from their homeland

#### What can you do with \$1Billion \$?

- 14,000 Elementary School Teachers salaries
- 13,789 Music and Arts Teachers salaries
- 146,000 University Students' scholarships
- 2,900 Affordable Housing Units
- 116,000 Head Start Places for Children
- 401,000 Uninsured Adults Could Get Health Care
- 364,000 Uninsured Children Could Obtain Health Care


